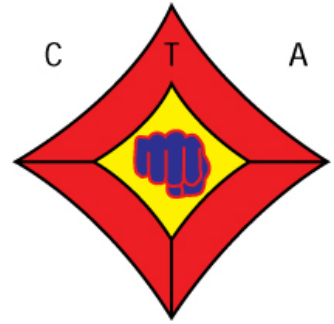

To calculate points.

1. The above person would receive 10 points if he was a third dan for only one year.
2. A person going for 4th dan and who has been a 3rd dan for 7 years would receive 32 1/2 points. (30 for minimum requirement of 6 1/2 years and 2.5 points for 1/2 year over minimum.

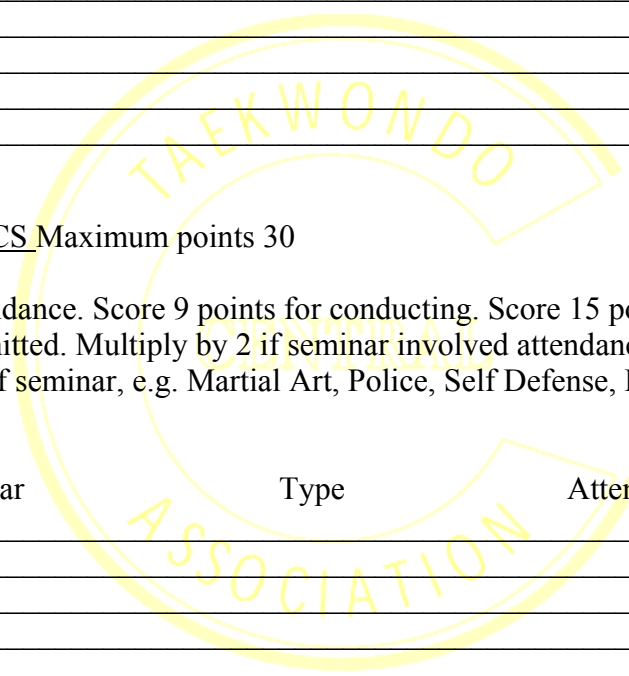
